## Greetings from Fr. Pat

### St. John Vianney

Last week, in the liturgical calendar, was the happy occasion to celebrate St. John Vianney on August 4th. St. John Vianney is the patron of parish priests, so has a particular connection for me. When I pray the rosary, at the end, I include a litany, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, pray for us!, St. Francis of Assisi, pray for us!, along with others, including St. John Vianney, pray for us!

St. John Vianney was born in France in 1786. He desired to be a priest at a young age and began schooling to do so, but evidently academics was not his strong suit, including the Latin language. But through perseverance he was ordained a priest at the age of 29. He would be assigned to the parish at Ars, France and would be there for 42 years! When he arrived, evidently the town of Ars and his parish were struggling. After a number of years things began to improve, people were coming back to church and the town of Ars was improving as well as more people were turning to God and spending less time in taverns, etc.

St. John Vianney was known for his ability to impart the faith in understandable ways. He was known for penance and mortification, especially in his early priesthood. In his later years, he became particularly known as a great confessor. He would hear hours of confessions a day, people coming from surrounding areas. So, he had many gifts. He provides a good example for parish priests and is relevant today as so many people are not going to church. Although, all was not easy for him, evidently, he suffered attacks from the devil for 34 years. Also, that he was persecuted by other priests for a number of years. So, it sounds like with this and other things, his efforts were not without difficulties.

My hope is to learn more about him. He died at the age of 74 in 1859 and was canonized a saint in 1925. Let us seek his intercession, especially for the parish priests in the Archdiocese. St. John Vianney, pray for us!

### Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary - August 15th

Ordinarily, the celebration of the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a holy day of obligation, but when it falls on a Saturday or a Monday, that obligation to attend Mass is lifted. So this year as it falls on Monday, it is not a holy day of obligation. Although it will still be celebrated, on August 15th, with Mass at St. Francis at 8:30am and at OLMC at 7:00pm.
